

## INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT

1. The name of the school is St Paul's Church of England Junior School, Wokingham
  2. The school is a Voluntary Controlled School.
  3. The name of the Governing Body is The Governing Body of St Paul's Church of England Junior School, Wokingham.
  4. The governing body shall consist of:
    - a) 4 parent governors
    - b) 1 local authority governor
    - c) 1 head teacher
    - d) 1 staff governor
    - e) 4 co-opted governors
    - f) 3 foundation governors
  5. The total number of governors shall be 14, except that, at any time when the head teacher has given written notice to the clerk to the governors that s/he does not wish to be a governor, the total shall be 13.
  6. Two foundation governors shall be appointed by the Oxford Diocesan Board of Education.
  7. (a) The holder of the following office shall be a foundation governor ex officio:

The Rector of Wokingham St Paul

(b) The Archdeacon of Berkshire shall be entitled to appoint a foundation governor in the place of the ex officio foundation governor whose governorship derives from the office named in (a) above in the event that that ex officio foundation governor is unable or unwilling to act as a foundation governor, or has been removed from office under regulation 21(1) of the Regulations, or where there is a vacancy in the office named in (a) above.
  - (c) The Archdeacon of Berkshire shall be entitled to request the removal of the ex officio foundation governor named in (a) above and to appoint a substitute foundation governor.
8. School ethos

Recognising its historic foundation, the school will preserve and develop its religious character in accordance with the principles of the Church of England and in partnership with the Church at parish and diocesan levels.

The school aims to serve its community by providing an education of the highest quality within the context of Christian belief and practice. It encourages an understanding of the meaning and significance of faith and promotes Christian values through the experience it offers to all of its pupils.

9. This instrument of government comes into effect on 25<sup>th</sup> June 2015.
10. This instrument was made by order of Wokingham Borough Council on 29<sup>th</sup> June 2015
11. A copy of the instrument must be supplied to every member of the governing body (and the head teacher if not a governor), any trustees and the Oxford Diocesan Board of Education.
