

### What shall I bring to school with me?

### Meet the Team

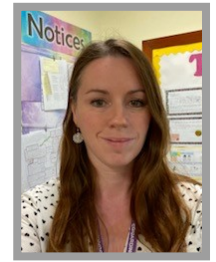
