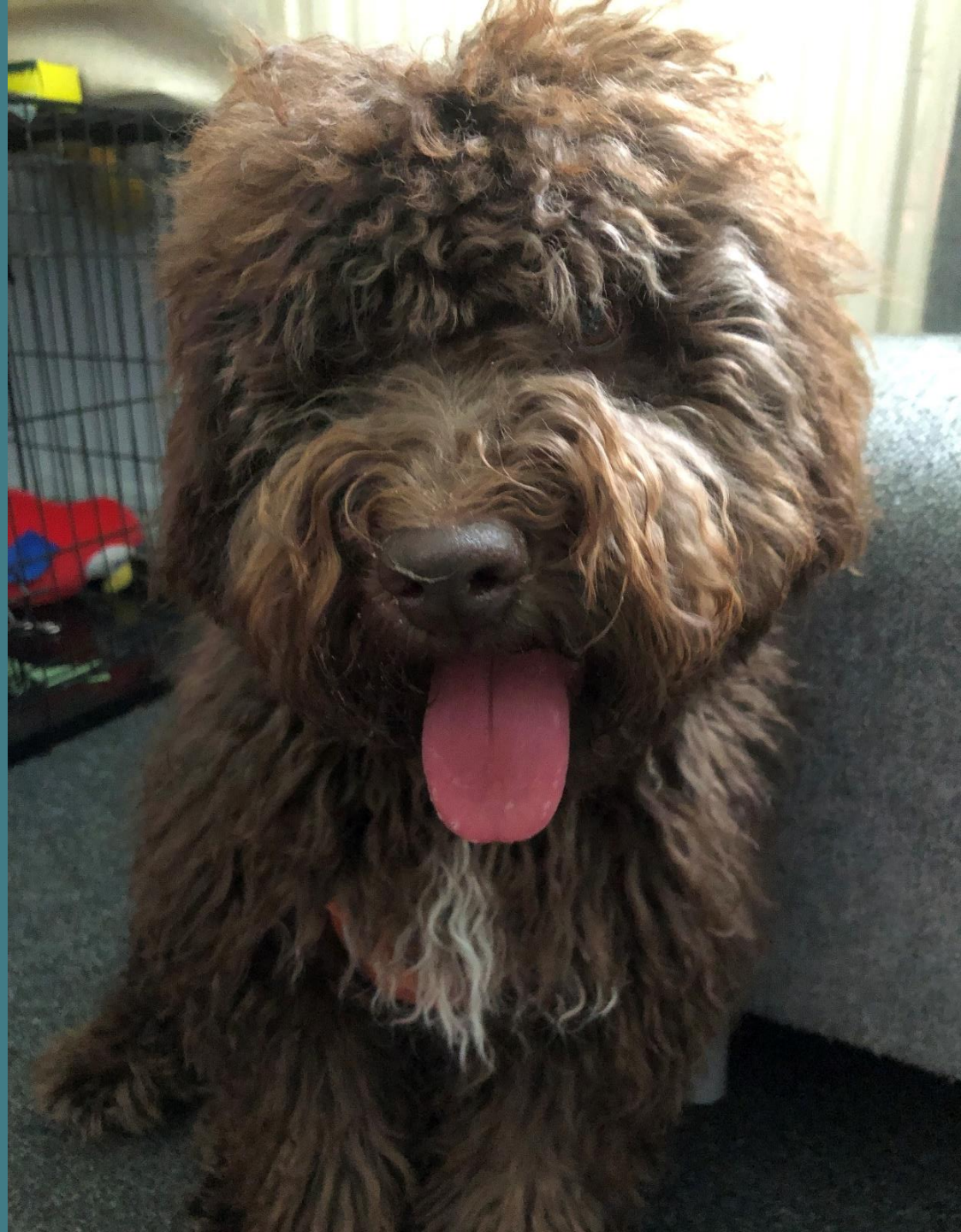

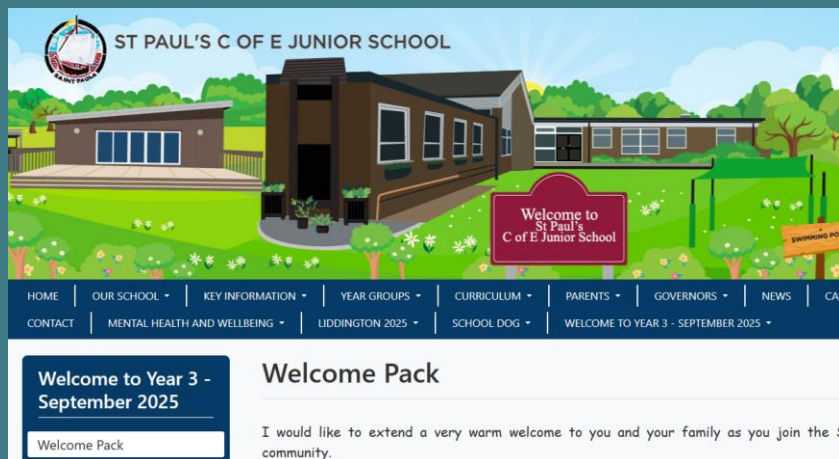
Parents say...
